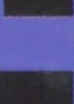
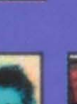

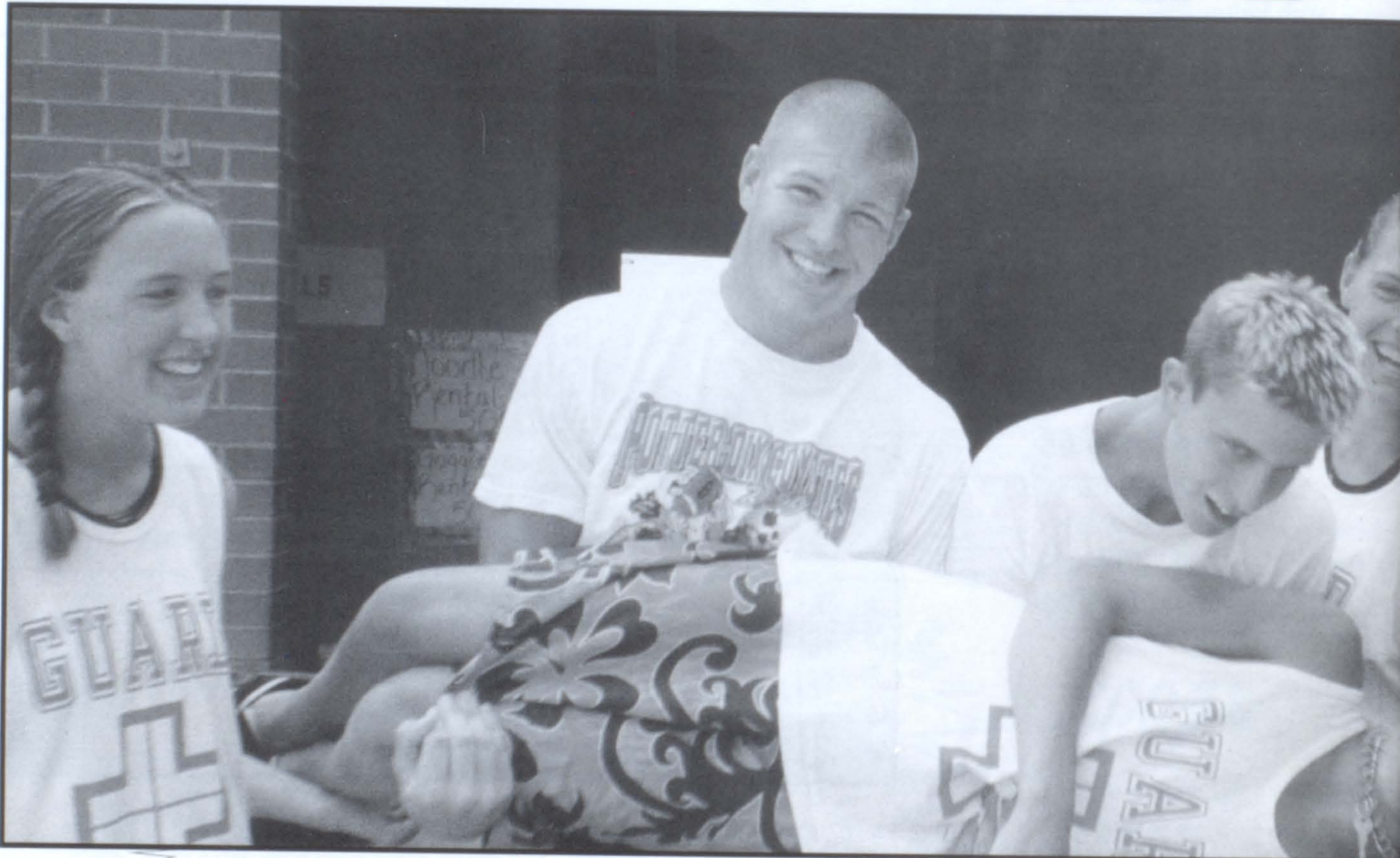

almost every day in the summer, certain people are held responsible for the lives of others. to hold this position they must attend a week of training which includes rescues, cpr, emergency training, swimming, and the test.

i caught up with justin leach on his lunch hour. he related his experiences as a life guard. "the scariest thing about being a lifeguard is having to actually go in and save someone. i would probably get really nervous and forget my training. i have never had to save a life, but there has been a close call that i almost had to. physically, if you can handle a workout of lots of swimming, then becoming a lifeguard is not hard. mentally, it gets kind of hard to remember everything you need to do."

savanna taylor talked with me at 2:10 during a break. "the scariest thing about being a lifeguard is having to jump in after someone and forgetting what i have to do procedure-wise. i have never had to save a life, but there was one time i thought that i might have to."

i caught up with ashley dorwart at the end of the day, just after closing time. dorwart revealed, "the scariest thing about being a lifeguard is the thought of actually having someone drown and knowing that you are responsible for each and every one of the people that are at the pool. thankfully, i have never had to save a life. however, i came so close that i had my shoes off and was ready to jump in. it was very nerve racking. if you know how to swim, becoming a lifeguard is not very hard; however, you have to be somewhat dedicated to do it. if you pay attention in the training classes, you will remember most of the trainings you need to know for the final test. basically, you have to pay attention and know how to swim."
