



Commons Hallway is probably the most popular of all the hallways in school.


During lunch students and teachers alike go and socialize with their friends. During the mornings you will commonly find students playing hacky sack with their companions or simply sitting on the bench and talking.


You can also usually find students that are in track or cross country waiting in the hallway for practice to begin you will also sometimes see cheerleaders practicing there.

Not only do hallways connect the school and classrooms together but they also connect the students and some of the faculty together.











The dance was a fundraiser for Student Council and the cost was \$3.00 for a single ticket and \$5.00 for a couple ticket. It was definitely a memorable night.








